H.R. 6049, the Renewable Energy and Job Creation Act extends:

- The investment tax credit (ITC) for solar energy by six years;
- The production tax credit (PTC) for energy derived from biomass, geothermal, hydropower, landfill
- The production tax credit (PTC) for energy derived from wind for one year.
