Washington, DC – Congressman Jerry McNerney (CA-11) announced that Morgan Hill’s Llagas Creek flood protection project will receive \$10 million in federal funding.

“I’m pleased to announce that the Llagas Creek Flood Protection Project will be able to take the next step in its development. These funds are essential for protecting homes, businesses and also restoring the creek’s natural habitat.”

The Llagas Creek Flood Protection Project encompasses a 13.6 mile area that runs from San Martin to Morgan Hill.
