Descriptions of the projects along with the dollar amounts secured appear below.

\$1,170,000 for the East Bay Regional Council of Governments to purchase equipment for a digital communications system

\$7,990,000 for Livermore-Fairfield Blue Rapid Transit: construction of a dedicated route for a Bus Rapid Transit

\$475,000 for I-580 HOV Funding will be used to add HOV lanes and make other operational improvements

\$2,871,000 for the San Francisco Bay Area Regional Water Program: construction of distribution pipelines to

\$1,000,000 for Los Vaqueros Reservoir Expansion: improve the quality of Bay Area water supplies delivered

\$1,337,000 for the Alameda Creek Watershed Project: demonstrate the use of bioengineered stream restoration
